2. Authors bear full responsibility for the content and literacy of submitted materials. *Note that the manuscripts will be published in author's edition, therefore, we highly recommend that participants thoroughly examine and proofread their papers before submitting*
3. Word Processing Formats
Language: Russian, English
Text format: Microsoft Word (*.doc, *.docx);
Page format: A4 (210x297 mm), portrait orientation
Margins: (top, bottom, left, right) 20 mm.
Font: size – 14; type - *Times New Roman*; interline spacing – 1,5
4. Place UDC number in the upper-right corner above title (Search UDC at: <http://teacode.com/online/udc/>)
5. Article title
6. Author(s) name(s), title(s), affiliations, City (town) (see example)
7. All photographs, graphs and diagrams must be *jpg, gif, bmp* format. Figures, and tables should be consecutively numbered and titled. Provide legends right below the figure. Place figures and tables in the text where appropriate (not at the end).
8. Place the reference list immediately below the main text. It should be named as «References». Enclose in-text citations in square brackets. It should comprise the number according to the numerical order in the reference list and cited pages separated by comma [5, p. 115].
9. At the end of the document (after the references) place author(s) name(s) and the copyright symbol (©).
10. Each Author can submit no more than 2 manuscripts – one as author and one as co-author.
11. Articles which are written by a group of more than 3 authors will be waived.
