Remarks

Lectures, except for Intensive Japanese, are given in English. The Schedule is subject to change without notice.

■ Requirements

1. Students must be currently enrolled in our partner universities / colleges (undergraduate/graduate).
2. Students who have taken a Japanese language course / class can apply for our summer school program.
3. The summer school will be held mainly in English. For students whose English is not the main language of instruction, the following level of language efficiency or its equivalence is recommended:
TOEFL pbt score: 500 TOEFL ibt score: 60

■ Number of students to be admitted

The maximum number of students to be accepted is 10 in total, while minimum required number of participants is 5. If more than 10 students apply, there will be a selection process held by Shimane University.

■ Accommodation

An off-campus dormitory at Shimane University is provided to all participant students during the summer school program. All participants will share a dorm room with 1 other student. A shared bathroom, toilet and kitchen will be available on each floor. Students will also participate in a home-stay for two nights.

■ Fees

80,000JPY

- 63,000JPY for tuition including textbooks, Home-stay, transport ,and all excursions.
- 17,000JPY for accommodation including common services and internet fees.

Remarks

1. Please e-mail the receipt of your remittance to our office **by May 15, 2018**. Account and payment information will be announced upon acceptance.
2. Payment will be accepted by overseas remittance to our bank in Japanese yen.
3. You may have to pay any additional fees charged by some banks including any handling fees and JPY exchange rate fees when you arrive in Shimane University.

■ Main expenses

- Food (Approx. 500-600 JPY/meal at a university cafeteria on weekdays)
- Fees for personal use of the attached equipment in the dormitory (100 yen for washing machine, shower, stove burner)
- Round trip ticket to Matsue
- Travel Insurance (See the details on the next page)
- All other personal expenses which are not mentioned above

■ Deadline for the Application

March 15, 2018

Students who wish to participant in this program should submit the following documents via e-mail

1. Application form (in a provided format)
2. A certificate of a TOEFL score or the other formal English exam score if the applicant is a non-native English speaker.

■ Certification for completing Summer School

At the end of the program, all participant students who join all the classes are provided with a certification of completion signed by the Director of Center for International Exchanges of Shimane University.

■ Notice

1. All the documents must be submitted to Shimane University through an office of international relations in applicant's home university.
2. It is not permitted for participant students to join any programs such as classes, internship, travels organized by any other institutions during the term of Summer School 2018.

Travel Information

Travel Insurance

All participants are required to purchase insurance from their home country before arriving at Shimane University and e-mail a copy of your insurance policy by May 15.

Visa

Students in countries that are not included in the Visa Waiver Program should receive a "Temporary Visitor Visa". Please apply for this visa at the Japanese embassy or consulate. "Invitation Letter", "Summer School Schedule" and "Guarantee" which are necessary for VISA application will be issued by Shimane University. If you have any questions about your visa, please contact your nearest Japanese embassy.

Coming to Shimane University

Participants should arrive at Matsue Station at **1p.m. on July 3, 2018** via the JR(Japan Railways). Upon your arrival, transportation will be provided from Matsue Station to Shimane University. Although we will gladly provide assistance, guide personnel to Matsue Station will not be provided. Details will be sent out upon acceptance.
